Swan Valley Dressage Association - Conditions of Entry

1. A completed entry on Nominate online acknowledges understanding and acceptance of all Conditions of Entry to this event. An EA disclaimer must be signed and submitted (via Nominate) or entry will not be accepted. This is a condition of insurance.
2. The event will be held in accordance with the current EA dressage rules (as amended). All competitors please be familiar with rules as the organizing committee will make no exceptions.
3. SVDA In – House Classes - To be eligible to enter SVDA In House competition, the rider must be a financial member of SVDA for 2018. Riders, horses and ponies do not need to be EWA registered to be eligible to compete. Members need to have entered 2 of the 3 previous qualifying classes during 2018 to enter the In-House High Point Classes.
4. Competitive Classes - to be eligible to enter a Competitive Class competition the rider must be a full financial member of the EWA. Horses and Ponies must be EWA registered and have a Dressage Performance Card or Pony Dressage Performance Card. Ponies must hold a current, valid EWA height certificate showing they do not exceed 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes.
5. **Eligibility to enter Participant classes under EWA Adult Riding membership** – rider must be a current member of a EWA Affiliated Adult Riding Club. The Adult Riding Club must also be a member of the Adult Riding Clubs Association of WA (ARCA).
6. Unless it is stated otherwise, arena familiarisation will occur from 7:20-7:45am on the day of competition.
 - An official must be present for the duration of the familiarisation
 - Horses & ponies must be mounted
 - Riders must follow any instructions from the responsible official
 - Competitor horses/ponies must wear identification numbers on the bridle or saddlecloth
 - Stallions must wear green discs on the bridle or saddlecloth
 - An official may direct an unruly horse or pony to be removed
7. Helper duties
 - To ensure sufficient coverage for all helper duties a mandatory helper fee will be charged per rider for each day of the competition.
 - SVDA Members only can nominate to complete a helper duty to be eligible for a refund.
8. Two arenas run concurrently for classes with the exception of FEI classes. Arenas will be a sand surface. Follow the marshal's instructions for entry to arenas. Warm-up area at rear of clubrooms will have a marshall directing the next rider to the competition arena.
9. Limited yards available on the day and are allocated on a first come basis – exception being stallions where a yard can be reserved. Please ensure you clean up manure and hay when you leave.
10. Float yards are not permitted at Venue
11. The organizing committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program or refuse entry. Entries will be accepted on a first come basis. However The organizing committee reserves the right to close classes when:
 - Participant, SVDA In House Competition—class allocation is full.
 - FEI / Competitive— class allocation is full, if there is an oversubscription of entries for class allocation, a ballot system will be adopted.
12. Callers are not permitted



13. Bridle and Saddletail numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse/pony at all times whilst being ridden or lunged.
14. Amendments to the draw may be made no later than 48 hours before the start of the event. Final responsibility is on the competitor to check the draw on the day of competition. Whilst every attempt will be made to adhere to the start times in the draw, it is the rider's responsibility to be aware via the Marshall if an arena is running ahead of schedule. If this does occur you may be asked to ride earlier than the draw time.
15. Riders who do not complete a gear check will incur elimination.
16. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 5 days of the completion of the event. In such cases 50% of the entry fees will be retained by SVDA. Entry fees will be refunded in full for riders on the ballot list who are not offered a start in the competition.
17. Warm up etiquette - Riding rules for warm up areas as documented in the EWA Handbook. Correct protocol in the warm up arena is expected. There is no lunging in the warm up areas. A round yard is provided for lunging. Helmets must be worn when lunging.
18. Officials, Ground Staff and Volunteers: These people are essential in the running of our competitions and events. Please treat them with respect. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Verbal or physical bullying behaviour will be reported to the CEO of EWA and disciplinary action will be taken where appropriate.
19. Duty of care: It is your responsibility to promptly report unsafe and or hazardous situations to the Event Organiser.
20. Disclaimer of Liability: Neither the Organising Committee, nor Swan Valley Dressage Association accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
